The Management of Scatolificio Niccoli di Niccoli A. & C. Sas is convinced that a company sensitive to the issues of responsible forest management and respectful of human rights can contribute both to the improvement of environmental conditions and to the improvement of people's well-being.

The Management is therefore committed to promoting responsible and consistent management of forest resources with respect for ethical and environmental values. With this in mind, it favours raw materials of FSC® forest origin, raising awareness of customers and suppliers towards full social responsibility.

It is therefore the policy of Scatolificio Niccoli di Niccoli A. & C. Sas:

- implement and maintain an adequate management and control system of the Chain of Custody concerning the products marketed with reference to the FSC® good forest management scheme;
- purchase FSC-certified® raw materials, as far as possible in relation to the willingness of its customers to have fair access to the benefits that derive from adherence to a sustainable and socially useful economy;
- promote and encourage the use of FSC® certified material among its customers.

Scatolificio Niccoli di Niccoli A. & C. Sas also declares that it has read and understood the "Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC", as published on the www.fsc.org website and which establishes FSC's position regarding unacceptable activities by organizations and individuals who are already or would like to join FSC®®.

In light of the above and of what is reported in the FSC-PRO-20-001 V1-1 Standard (Appendix B), Scatolificio Niccoli di Niccoli A. & C. Sas explicitly undertakes, now and in the future, provided that the relationship with FSC® is in place, not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- a) Illegal logging or illegal trade in timber or forest products;
- b) Violation of human and traditional rights during forestry operations;
- c) Destruction of high conservation values during forestry operations;
- d) Significant conversions of forests to plantations or for other non-forest uses;
- e) Introduction of genetically modified organisms into forestry operations;
- f) Violation of any of the ILO's core conventions as defined in the ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work.

Scatolificio Niccoli di Niccoli A. & C. Sas is also committed to sharing and disseminating the above principles to all staff and other interested parties.
